Micheal K. Funk of West Lafayette tonight received the coveted Phil N. Eskew Award for Mental Attitude for Class AA.

The award presentation, by Robert B. Gardner of the IHSAA Executive Committee, followed the 12th annual Class AA championship football game between West Lafayette and Chatard in the Hoosier Dome; the first Class AA title clash ever in the 61,000-seat stadium.

Named after Eskew, IHSAA Commissioner 14 years before retiring in 1975, the award is given annually to an outstanding senior in the championship game for mental attitude, scholarship, leadership and football ability.

Funk is the 12th Class AA player and the first from West Lafayette to receive the award.

The 5-11, 155-pound wide receiver and defensive back chalked up a banner 1984 season. Going into the Championship game, he led the Red Devils in scoring (60 points), pass receptions (40) and yards (690), (both single season school records) and touchdown passes (9). He made the All-Hoosier Conference team in football and baseball.

Funk's ability extends beyond athletics. He is also an outstanding debater, student government leader and National Honor Society member. He ranks 15th in the 144-member senior class.

Following graduation, he plans to major in pre-law at Stanford University. He also eyes a professional baseball career.

He lives with his father, Christopher Funk, at 2312 N. 650 West, in West Lafayette.
