HEARINGS

A hearing was conducted to consider the appeal of J.C. Kinnaird, a student attending Floyd Central High School. J.C. had been declared to have limited eligibility on the basis of Rule 19-6.2. A hearing was requested in order to appeal the ruling and obtain full eligibility. Following the hearing the student's family and legal counsel for the IHSAA submitted findings of fact. Having analyzed all of the available data, the IHSAA Review Committee voted to uphold the decision of the Commissioner.

A hearing was conducted to consider the appeal of Wesley Beck, a student attending Rochester High School. Wesley had been declared to have limited eligibility on the basis of Rule 19-6.2. A hearing was requested in order to appeal the ruling and obtain full eligibility. Following the hearing the student's family and legal counsel for the IHSAA submitted findings of fact. Having analyzed all of the available data, the IHSAA Review Committee voted to modify the decision of the Commissioner and award limited eligibility until December 31, 2013, and full eligibility thereafter.

A hearing was conducted to consider the appeal of Mitchell and Mathew Moore, students attending Bremen High School. Mitchell and Mathew had been declared ineligible on the basis of Rule 19-6.4. A hearing was requested in order to appeal the ruling and obtain limited eligibility. Following the hearing the student's family and legal counsel for the IHSAA submitted findings of fact. Having analyzed all of the available data, the IHSAA Review Committee voted to uphold the decision of the Commissioner.
