2002-03 IHSAA Girls Basketball State Tournament Series

State Finals Summary

Kokomo, Beech Grove, Shenandoah and Tri-Central were left standing as state champions during the 28th Annual IHSAA Girls Basketball State Finals held March 8, 2003 at Conseco Fieldhose in Indianapolis.

A total of 381 schools and 5,251 student-athletes were entered into sectional competition for this year's tournament.

Class 4A -- Kokomo Survives Last Second Shot For State Title

Top-ranked Kokomo scrapped back in the late going for its third state championship with a 44-42 victory over Perry Meridian in the Class 4A state title game.

It was the Wildkats' first title since back-to-back championships in 1992 and 1993 and their first under coach Charlie Hall. This Kokomo squad completed a perfect campaign at 26-0, something the previous Wildkat teams weren't able to do.

Down 41-37 with under two minutes remaining, Kokomo's Ann Thatcher stole the ball and drilled a three-pointer at the other end that cut the deficit to one point. After a Perry Meridian turnover, Lisa Thompson scored a layin to give Kokomo the lead at 42-41.

Following a Perry Meridian missed field goal two possessions later, Thatcher was fouled and converted both free throws for a three point cushion. Kokomo then fouled the Falcons' Kelsey Gurganus who made the first of two free throws with :12.6 to go. Her second attempt bounced off but Christina Cunningham grabbed the offensive rebound for Perry Meridian and called timeout with :05.2 left to set up the final shot.

On the inbounds pass, the Falcons got it in to Laura Gaybrick in the post but her turnaround was off the mark as time expired.

Thatcher led Kokomo in scoring with 16 points, Thompson finished with 12 and Hendrix 11. Cunningham led Perry Meridian with 16 points of her own and had a game-high 13 rebounds. Heather Burleson collected 11 boards. Mike Armstrong coached the ninth-ranked Falcons to their first appearance in the state finals finishing the season at 24-5.

Kokomo led at the half, 24-21, but Perry Meridian outscored the Wildkats in the third period by a 12-4 count, including a 9-1 run that stretched from the 5:21 mark to just under a minute to go that put the Falcons on top 33-28 to begin the fourth period.

Laura Gaybrick of Perry Meridian was named winner of the 2003 Patricia L. Roy Mental Attitude Award in Class 4A Basketball. Farm Bureau Insurance, IHSAA corporate partner, presented a \$1,000.00 scholarship to Perry Meridian High School in the name of Gaybrick.

Class 3A -- Gearlds' Record 33 Points Leads Beech Grove To Championship

Katie Gearlds scored a Class 3A record 33 points and led second-ranked Beech Grove to a 63-45 victory over unranked South Bend St. Joseph's in the Class 3A state championship game.

It was the first state championship in any sport for Beech Grove, a town surrounded by Indianapolis inside Marion County.

Gearlds' 33 points also tied for the third best output ever in the IHSAA state finals. One of the nation's top players this year, the 6-1 senior finished fourth on the state's career scoring chart with 2,521 points and led the state in scoring this year with a 30.1 average. She reached the 2,500 point mark for her career with her first basket of the second period. She also pulled down 12 rebounds, had three steals and blocked four shots in the game.

The Hornets, coached by Dawn McNew, outscored the Indians 15-2 in the second period to take a 29-11 lead and never were threatened after that. Beech Grove led by as many as 23 points at 46-23 with 3:03 remaining in the third period. St. Joseph's 17 turnovers were also critical to their demise as Beech Grove scored 20 points off their miscues.

Emily Ringham added eight points for Beech Grove and Jenni Moore tallied nine rebounds.

St. Joseph's, making its debut in the state finals, was led in scoring by Allison Lindborg with 17 points and Melissa Lechlitner with 16. The 24-3 Indians were coached by Mike Megyese.

Katie Gearlds of Beech Grove was named winner of the 2003 Patricia L. Roy Mental Attitude Award in Class 3A Basketball. Farm Bureau Insurance, IHSAA corporate partner, presented a \$1,000.00 scholarship to Beech Grove High School in the name of Katie Gearlds.

Class 2A -- Amanda Norris' Free Throws Lift Shenandoah To First Championship

Shenandoah senior Amanda Norris hit a pair of free throws with :02.1 remaining to give Shenandoah a 52-51 victory over defending champion Southwestern (Hanover) in a rematch of last year's Class 2A state championship game.

Down 51-50 in the closing seconds, Norris was fouled under the basket and stepped to the line and calmly sank both free throws to put the Raiders back on top. Southwestern's desperation heave at the buzzer was off the mark.

Norris' clutch free throws followed an incredible play by Catherine Graham of Southwestern who was fouled on a made three pointer from the wing that tied the game at 50-50. Graham hit the ensuing foul shot to give the Rebels the lead with just eight seconds remaining.

It was the first state championship in any sport for Shenandoah, a school located in Middletown in Henry County. The team's third consecutive trip to the state finals proved to be the charm as the Raiders had fallen short each of the two previous years, including last year's 70-64 loss to Southwestern in the final.

The game was the first rematch of the previous year's championship game in tournament history and was the second Shenandoah win of the season over Southwestern. The Raiders had taken a 72-60 victory in the Hall of Fame Classic semifinals last December 27.

Norris finished with a game-high 20 points on 7-of-12 shots. She also collected 10 rebounds. Chelsea Miller and Kara Keesling added 14 each. Graham finished with 19 points and Julie Brawner 14 for Southwestern.

Coached by Todd Salkoski, fifth-ranked Shenandoah completed a 24-5 season, while eighth-ranked Southwestern finished 21-8. The Rebels were coached by Donna Cheatham, Indiana's all-time winningest coach in the girls game.

Amanda Norris of Shenandoah High School was named winner of the 2003 Patricia L. Roy Mental Attitude Award in Class 2A Girls Basketball. Farm Bureau Insurance, IHSAA corporate partner, presented a \$1,000.00 scholarship to Shenandoah High School in the name of Amanda Norris.


Class A -- Tri-Central Rally Knocks Off Defending Champ North Vermillion

Tri-Central preyed on three North Vermillion turnovers in the final minute of play and rallied to top the defending Class A state champion Falcons, 57-55, for its first state championship in school history.


Trailing 52-46 with 2:54 remaining in the game, the second-ranked Trojans outscored the top-ranked Falcons 11-3 the rest of the way. The rally began when North Vermillion turned the ball over on three consecutive trips down the floor allowing the Tri-Central to creep within 52-50. After a Lindsay Varner free throw to put North Vermillion up 53-50, Meranda Burnett connected for Tri-Central and Kristen Miller's layup at 0:47 gave the Trojans their first lead since 6:11 of the third period.

Sarah Boyle added two free throws and Amanda Watson converted one of two from the line in the final seconds. Miller, Tri-Central's 5-11 junior center, scored a career high 24 points on 9-of-11 shooting and also pulled down 14 rebounds. Burnett scored 12 points and Boyle 10 for the 23-4 Trojans, who were coached by Kathie Layden. North Vermillion's Allison Hughes topped all scorers with a Class A championship game record 25 points. The Falcons (26-1), which had their 50-game winning streak snapped with the loss, were coached by Ken Gentrup. Both teams combined for 39 turnovers in the contest.




