Attorney Robert Baker updated the Executive Committee on the current status of pending litigation against the Association.

### **Penalties Assessed**

Ben Davis HS – Rule 3-9.4 (*Four student athletes participated in a Unified Flag Football Sectional contest while not appearing on the sectional entry list*)

1. The Ben Davis High School Unified Flag Football program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The student athletes involved in this violation are ineligible for the remainder of the tournament series.

Blackford HS – Scrimmage Rules Violation (*Girls' basketball coach attended a scrimmage of a future opponent*)

1. The Blackford High School girls' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Mitch Waters shall be suspended for one regular season contest on the Blackford girls' basketball schedule. This suspension must occur within the first three games of the Blackford High School girls' basketball schedule.

Connersville HS – Rule 101-1 (*Volleyball team did not complete 10 separate days of practice prior to their first contests*)

1. The Connersville High School volleyball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Torrie Whitmore is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable rationale for a rules violation.
3. The interscholastic contests played by the Connersville volleyball teams shall be forfeited if Connersville was victorious. The opposing schools shall be made aware of this violation.

Dugger Union HS – Rule 19-3 (*Football player participated in a contest without an approved transfer report on file*)

1. The Dugger Union High School football program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that a rule violation has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.

2. The student is declared ineligible until a completed transfer report is submitted and ruled upon.
3. The contest where the ineligible athlete participated in shall be forfeited if Dugger Union was victorious. The opposing school shall be notified of this violation.

Goshen HS – Rule 3-10 (*Girls' golfer participated the entire season without an approved pre-participation physical and consent form on file*)

1. The Goshen High School girls' golf program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Co-Head Coaches Jenna Pacenka and Charlie Walesa are reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. This is a health and safety issue and it is absolutely imperative that the "IHSAA Pre-Participation Evaluation Form" complete in every detail be on file for all student athletes prior to their participation in a practice, let alone an interscholastic contest.
3. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student provides a valid pre-participation physical and consent form to the school.
4. It is understood that the student athlete participated at the junior varsity level and there are no team scores to readjust.

Harrison (West Lafayette) HS – Rule 50-4 (*Boys' Cross Country runner participated in the tournament series while failing to meet minimum regular season participation standards*)

1. The Harrison High School boys' cross country program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Chris Cahee is reprimanded for permitting this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable explanation for a rules violation.
3. The ineligible athlete is disqualified from the IHSAA cross country tournament series.
4. In accordance with rule 3-9-4b of the IHSAA By-Laws, the ineligible athlete shall be removed from the results and team scores shall be refigured for the Harrison (West Lafayette) regional meet.

Leo HS – Rule 15-2.2c (*Softball coach provided instruction to a ninth grader on a non-school sponsored team*)

1. The Leo High School softball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Matt Lauer is reprimanded for this violation. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable excuse for a rules violation.

New Albany HS – Rule 101-4 (*Three Girls' Cross Country runners participated in the tournament series while failing to meet minimum regular season participation standards*)

1. The New Albany High School girls' cross country program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Coach Vince Houge is reprimanded for permitting this violation to occur. Ignorance of the rules is not an acceptable explanation for a rules violation.
3. The ineligible athletes are disqualified from the IHSAA cross country tournament series.
4. In accordance with rule 3-9-4b of the IHSAA By-Laws, the ineligible athletes shall be removed from the results and team scores shall be refigured for the Crawford County sectional and the Crawford County regional meets.

Rock Creek Academy – Rule 3-10 (*Girls' basketball player participated in practice without an approved pre-participation physical and consent form on file*)

1. The Rock Creek Academy girls' basketball program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. Head Coach Kevin White is reprimanded for allowing this violation to occur. This is a health and safety issue and it is absolutely imperative that the "IHSAA Pre-Participation Evaluation Form" complete in every detail be on file for all student athletes prior to their participation in a practice.
3. The student involved in this violation is declared ineligible until such time the student provides a fully completed pre-participation physical and consent form to the school.

South Bend Saint Joseph HS – Rule 15-1.3 a. (*Girls' soccer player participated in a non-school sponsored camp during the authorized contest season*)

1. The South Bend Saint Joseph High School girls' soccer program is issued a warning. This warning is official notice that an illegal act has occurred, is a matter of record, and shall not be repeated.
2. The IHSAA accepts the one game suspension by South Bend Saint Joseph High School of Colleen Harley from the IHSAA girls' sectional championship game as a sufficient measure in this matter.
