Join Us Sunday for the IHSAA Football State Tournament Pairings Show

First round sectional matchups in the 43rd Annual IHSAA Football State Tournament presented by the Indianapolis Colts will be announced Sunday, Oct. 11, in a 90-minute telecast beginning at 5 pm ET / 4 pm CT.

The pairings show will be televised exclusively on [Fox Sports Indiana \(FSI\)](http://FoxSportsIndiana.com), the home of IHSAA championships. Originating from Lucas Oil Stadium in Indianapolis, the show will be hosted by legendary broadcaster Jerry Baker, Kyle Neddenriep of the Indianapolis Star and Jeremiah Johnson of Fox Sports Indiana.

The following coaches are expected to appear as part of the program: Class A, Mike Johnson (Pioneer); Class 2A, Kevin Hutchins (Monrovia); Class 3A, Shane Fry (West Lafayette); Class 4A, Andy Hape (Evansville Reitz); Class 5A, Bob Gaddis (Columbus East); Class 6A, Eric Moore (Center Grove).

For viewers outside of the Fox Sports Indiana coverage area, a live stream will be available at IHSAAtv.org. For those within the FSI coverage area, the stream will be available only on delayed basis later that evening.

From 6-8 pm ET, radio listeners may join Indiana Sports Talk's Bob Lovell and Paul Condry of Regional Radio Sports Network for their pairings show on any of the affiliates of the [IHSAA Champions Radio Network](http://IHSAAChampionsRadioNetwork.com). Originating from Emmis Communications on Monument Circle in downtown Indianapolis, Lovell and Condry will go in-depth on some of the top sectionals in all six classes and collect reaction from coaches across the state.

At approximately 6:30 pm ET / 5:30 pm CT, complete brackets will be available on IHSAA.org.

Volleyball Tournament Drawing Monday Morning

The IHSAA will conduct the blind draw for the 44th Annual Volleyball State Tournament on Monday, Oct. 12, beginning at 8 am ET / 7 am CT. Pairings will be e-mailed to IHSAA member school athletic directors and news media and posted to IHSAA.org upon completion.

The tournament brackets on MaxPreps.com and available via IHSAA.org will begin to be populated by the IHSAA once the pairings have been released.

Sectional matches begin Tuesday, Oct. 20 and continue through Saturday, Oct. 24.
