THE 44TH ANNUAL IHSAA GIRLS GOLF STATE FINALS

Sept. 30-Oct. 1, 2016
Prairie View Golf Club, Carmel, Ind.

A total of 15 teams have advanced five golfers each and 25 individuals have made it here without their squads for a total of 100 participants. All teams and players will play 36 holes. Groups will be teeing off the 1st and 10th tees at 8:30 am ET / 7:30 am CT on Friday and at the same time on Saturday.

- Second-ranked Evansville North will look to become just the second school to win three consecutive state championships this weekend. The Huskies will attempt to join Martinsville which captured three straight in 1991, 1992 and 1993 as well as a six year string from 1995-2000.
- Evansville North had a pair of outstanding rounds the last two weeks. The Huskies shot a 290, the lowest sectional round in state tournament history at Fendrich Golf Course in Evansville on Sept. 17. It was the Huskies fifth consecutive sectional crown. The team followed up with the second-lowest regional round in tournament history last Saturday when it fired a 296 at Country Oaks Golf Club in Montgomery for their third straight regional championship.
- Top-ranked Westfield, last year's state runner-up, tied for the third lowest regional score in tournament history last Saturday when it carded a 297 at Smock Golf Course in Indianapolis. The effort landed the second consecutive regional crown for the Shamrocks.
- Westfield's girls will attempt to join the school's boys team which won its second straight state title on June 15 on the Prairie View course and third in four years.
- Lake Central's Alexis Miestowski is the defending state champion and returns to the state finals with her 12th-ranked Indian teammates. If she tops the field once again, the junior would become the eighth player with two or more state crowns. She won the sectional at Palmira with a 68 on Sept. 16 and followed with a 73, which tied her for second place at Battle Ground last Saturday. She'll tee off at 10:18 am on Friday.
- A record number of schools and players were represented in this year's sectional tournaments including 306 schools and 1,939 players. The previous high of 290 teams was reached in 2012 and again in 2015 while 1,915 players were entered in the 2010 state tournament.
