THE 81ST ANNUAL IHSAA BOYS GOLF STATE FINALS

June 13-14, 2017 Prairie View Golf Club, Carmel, Ind.

A total of 15 teams have advanced five golfers each and 25 individuals have made it here without their squads for a total of 100 participants. All teams and players will play 36 holes. Groups will be teeing off the $1^{\rm st}$ and $10^{\rm th}$ tees at 8 am ET / 7 am CT on Tuesday and at the same time on Wednesday.

- Third-ranked Westfield is the two-time defending state champion and winner in three of the last four years. With a victory on Wednesday, they would become the first school in tournament history to win three consecutive state titles.
- Top-ranked Center Grove, last year's third-place team, tallied a 278 on Thursday, the second-lowest regional score ever. Only a 276 put up by Richmond in 2003 at Edgewood Country Club was better. The effort landed a third consecutive regional crown for the Trojans. With a 288 the week before at their own sectional at Hickory Stick, Center Grove has posted the two lowest scores this state tournament.
- Center Grove junior Noah Gillard, the Trojans' #1 player, was last year's state runner-up to Hamilton Southeastern's Cedric McAree. McAree has graduated so a new individual state champion is assured this week.
- Second-ranked Carmel is making its first team appearance in three years and 31st overall thanks to a state-best 13th regional crown Thursday at Battle Ground near

Lafayette. The team will contend for the school's eighth state championship this school year which would set a state record. The Greyhounds' boys track and field and girls tennis teams' both won state championships last weekend equaling their own state record of seven titles in one school year set in 2010-11.

■ Twelve players have carded sub70 scores in the state tournament so far. Seven went 68 or better including Clay Merchent of Noblesville who led all with a 66 at The Players Club in Muncie on Thursday. Perry Meridian's Nick Osterburg, Corydon Central's Joey Wiseman and Columbus North's Matt Vorndran each fired 67s while 68s were turned in by Eric Brinker of Evansville North, Jack Cunningham of Vincennes Lincoln and Nicholas Ramsey of Carroll (Fort Wayne).
