## Basketball, Wrestling Tournament Pairings Shows Scheduled

Plans for the tournament pairings shows for three winter sports were announced today by the Indiana High School Athletic Association.

Pairings for the  $46^{th}$  girl basketball state tournament will be revealed on Sunday, Jan. 24 beginning at 7 pm ET / 6 CT.

The opening round games for the 111<sup>th</sup> boys basketball state tournament will be announced on Sunday, Feb. 21 at 7 pm ET / 6 CT.

Both two-hour programs, hosted by Bob Lovell and Greg Rakestraw, will stream exclusively on the IHSAA's video portal at <a href="IHSAAtv.org">IHSAAtv.org</a> (no television) and via <a href="affiliates">affiliates</a> of the IHSAA Champions Radio Network.



Immediately following both shows, all sectional pairings will be available online at IHSAA.org.

Pairings for the 83<sup>rd</sup> IHSAA Wrestling State Finals will be announced on Sunday, Feb. 14 (the day after the semi-state round) at 4 pm ET / 3 CT via IHSAAtv.org.

Each bracket in the 14 weight classes will be revealed by Rakestraw and Hall of Fame coach Mike Goebel beginning with the 106 pound weight class and continue through the 285 pounders.
