### JEFF RHODY OF CROWN POINT TO BE HONORED AS BASKETBALL'S **OUTSTANDING OFFICIAL**

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals.

Jeff Rhody is the 2020-21 recipient of the Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award of Excellence in the sport of Girls Basketball.

Indiana recognizes 24 separate officials' associations across the state. Each year these 24 associations nominate multiple individuals for the



Outstanding Official Award presented in each sport.

An active member of the Lake County Officials Association, Rhody has served as the Director of Basketball for the past six (6) years. He also assumes a mentoring position within his association; annually teaching the "Hatch" class where potential basketball officials are recruited, trained and assisted with their officiating profession. Rhody also mentors within the youth softball program in Lake County; assisting with clinics, recruiting events, and training. Licensed for the past 31 years, he has officiated 20 basketball sectionals, 13 regionals, seven semistates, and four state finals; including his last appearance in 2019.

In addition to Rhody's work as a basketball official and youth softball mentor, he is also a licensed track and field and cross country official for the IHSAA.

Off the court, Rhody is an educator by passion and degree; teaching biology and physics at Lake Central High School. Extending his classroom beyond 3 pm, he is also the Lake Central track and field head coach. Through his leadership, support of the Unified programming at Lake Central is an annual effort from all student-athletes involved with the track and field programs.

Rhody is a graduate of Portage High School and earned his Bachelor's and Master's degrees in Secondary Education from Ball State University. He and his wife, Sonya, have two children, AJ and Samantha.






