JAY SLATER TO BE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

Jay Slater is the recipient of the 2021 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Baseball. Slater will be honored in a special ceremony at this week's State Finals.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Slater was selected for this honor by a committee representing the Indiana officials associations. Jay has been a licensed Baseball official for 27 years. During that time, he has officiated 22 sectionals, 16 regionals, eight (8) semi-states, and seven (7) state finals. He is also licensed in basketball and football. He has officiated eight (8) basketball state finals and two (2) football state finals. Jay has also served as a IHSAA Clinician and Rules Interpreter.

Slater is a member of the Wabash Valley Officials Association, where he has previously served as board member and president. Jay also takes time to mentor other high school and little league umpires.

Slater is a graduate of Shakamak High School and is currently a Safety and Environmental Engineer at Sony. Jay and his wife Cindy reside in Sullivan and have two children, Heather (36), and Ashlee (34).

MILES MANN OF EVANSVILLE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIAL AWARD

Miles Mann is the recipient of the 2020 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of baseball. Although there was no baseball season in 2020, Official of the Year had already been named. Miles was honored in a special ceremony during the sectional round of this year's State Tournament.



Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic

Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.

Mann was selected for this honor by a committee representing the Indiana officials associations. A member of the

Southern Indiana Officials Association, Miles has officiated 27 sectionals, 11 regionals, eight (8) semi-states, and six (6) state finals during his 30 years as a licensed baseball official. He is also licensed in basketball, football, and softball.

Miles is a graduate of the University of Evansville with the field study of Mechanical Engineering. Currently, Miles works as the Assistant Director of Facility Operations at the University of Southern Indiana (USI) and has for 30 years. In addition to his involvement in high school athletics, Mann works with local youth programs for both baseball and basketball. He also assists as the Official Scorkeeper for USI Women's Basketball, volunteers with the Special Olympics and serves as a Rules Interpreter for PONY and Bronco Zone Tournaments.

Miles and his wife Andrea reside in Evansville and have three children, Lindsay (28), Daniel (25) and Jack (19).

- With a victory, Aaron Willard would become the first coach to win both a softball and baseball state championship in state history. Willard, a 1984 Eastside graduate, coached the softball team to that 1998 crown. He is in his sixth year coaching the baseball team (.759 104-33).
