#### CUMBERLAND'S MIKE EASON TO BE HONORED AS BASKETBALL'S OUTSTANDING OFFICIAL FOR 2021

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the state final tournament.

Mike Eason of Cumberland is the recipient of the 2020-21 IHSAA Outstanding Official Award for Boys Basketball. Mike has been a licensed official for the past 30 years and is a member of the Indiana Officials Association where he has served as Treasurer and as a board member.

During his career, he has officiated 24 boys' basketball sectionals, 14 regionals, seven (7) semi-states, and four (4) state finals. Mike has worked a combined nine (9) basketball state finals between boys' and girls'. He is



finals between boys' and girls'. He is also a licensed football official and has worked two football state finals.

Mike was selected for this honor by a committee representing the officials associations. In Indiana, there are 24 associations made up of more than 7,000 men and women who assist in providing wholesome, worthwhile, and healthy activities for the student-athletes in our state. Statewide, there are more than 8,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 11 sports.

A 1982 graduate of South Newton High School, Mike works as a Mortgage Loan Officer for Indiana Members Credit Union. Mike has served as an IHSAA Clinician for Basketball and Football and has earned numerous awards for his outstanding officiating. He has three children and currently resides with his wife, Susie, of 22 years.

receive a year ago until the pandemic cancelled the state tournament.


Andy has been a licensed basketball official for the past 29 years and is a member of the Lake County Officials Association for which he serves as a Local Association Clinician.






