Purchased tickets will be sent as mobile tickets to the purchaser's smart phone and that verification should be shown at the admission gate. Participating schools will also have digital tickets to sell in their own sections during the week of the state finals.

PARKING

There are multiple parking options throughout the downtown area that are within walking distance of the Fieldhouse. The Virginia Avenue Garage, which charges a fee and is located directly to the east of the venue, connects to the Fieldhouse from the third floor of the garage via a walkway over Delaware Street. The entrance to the Virginia Avenue Garage is located off of Maryland Street.

GATES OPEN

Gainbridge Fieldhouse will open its gates to fans beginning one hour prior to the start of each session -- 9:30 am ET and 5 pm ET. The venue will be cleared between the Class 2A and 3A games.

SOUTH BEND'S JIMMY ARNETT TO BE HONORED AS BASKETBALL'S OUTSTANDING OFFICIAL

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals.

Jimmy Arnett is the 2021-22 recipient of the Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award of Excellence in the sport of Girls Basketball.

Indiana recognizes 24 separate officials' associations across the state and, each year, these 24 associations nominate multiple individuals for

the Outstanding Official Award that is presented in each sport.

The current president of the Saint Joe Valley Official's Association, Jimmy has also served as the Director of Basketball for six years and continues to assist with assignment of officials for local schools.

Outside of the basketball court, Mr. Arnett is also licensed in the sports of softball and volleyball; assisting with clinics and trainings annually in service to officials in his area.

Licensed for the past 30 years, Jimmy has officiated 23 Basketball Sectionals, 17 Regionals, six Semi-States, and three State Finals.

Off the court, Jimmy spends countless hours supporting local fundraising efforts; the Food Bank of Northern Indiana, Marine Corps Toys for Tots, Special Olympics, to name a few. Jimmy, his wife Merie, and their two daughters, Sara and Janelle, reside in South Bend, Indiana.

Mr. Arnett continues to be instrumental in the recruitment, mentoring and training of officials in Indiana. His level of commitment to his craft has proven to benefit countless officials, not just within his own association, but across the entire State of Indiana.
