Steve Kline of Schererville is the recipient of the 2021 IHSAA Outstanding Volleyball Official Award in the state of Indiana.

Kline

has been a licensed volleyball official for over 30 years and is a member of the Lake County Officials Association.



Kline, a Pennsylvania

native, got his start officiating working YMCA Recreational Leagues at the age of 16. He volunteered many hours assisting the young people of Pennsylvania and also took the initiative to help improve the officiating in his community. Steve established a new chapter of officials in Berks County, PA in order to support the growing number of leagues in the community and served on the leadership team and as a rules interpreter. He was a licensed PAVO official and a licensed PIAA official for 10 years prior to his move to Indiana.

Steve has been a licensed volleyball and Basketball official in Indiana for the past 20 years. He is also a licensed official in Illinois. He has worked 15 IHSAA volleyball sectionals, nine regionals, five semi-states and two state finals matches during his career. Steve also serves as a local association clinician in Lake County.

Kline, a purchasing/industry manager for PepsiCo, resides with his wife of 32 years, Judy. They have five children together.

Kline was selected for this honor by a committee representing the officials associations. In Indiana, there are 24 associations made up of more than 6,000 men and women who assist in providing wholesome, worthwhile, and healthy activities for the studentathletes in our state. Statewide, there are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 18 sports.

"No person in the United States shall on the basis of sex be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subject to discrimination under any education programs or activity receiving federal financial assistance."

Those words, the preamble to Title IX, signed into law on June 23, 1972 by President Richard M. Nixon, changed the athletics landscape in public schools across the country.

With it, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, under Commissioner Phil Eskew and the Association's first Director of Girls Athletics Pat Roy, initiated seven state tournaments for girls in various sports over the next four years. The first of which was volleyball.

The IHSAA is proud to join the National Federation of State High School Associations (NFHS) and other state associations across the country in celebrating the inspirational individuals and landmark moments in the history of Title IX, and continuing to grow the educational and competitive opportunities for the future.
