Track State Finals move to Ben Davis HS, Softball to Center Grove HS

IHSAA Commissioner Paul Neidig today announced the state finals host sites for two spring state tournaments.

Following conversations with the IHSAA Executive Committee, this year's Boys, Girls and Unified Track & Field State Finals will be contested at Ben Davis High School in Indianapolis. The boys meet will be contested on Friday, June 4 while the unified meet and girls meet are set for Saturday, June 5.

The Softball State Finals will be played at Center Grove High School in Greenwood on Friday, June 11 and Saturday, June 12.

The track meets had been planned for Indiana University's Robert C. Haugh Track and Field Complex in Bloomington while the softball games had been scheduled for Purdue University's Bittinger Stadium in West Lafayette.

Both universities had confirmed last month they would be unable to host the IHSAA events with spectators on the scheduled dates.

The IHSAA would like to express its appreciation to the member schools who stepped up to offer their assistance in hosting these events.

About the Indiana High School Athletic Association, Inc. (IHSAA)

The IHSAA is a voluntary, not-for-profit organization that is self-supporting without the use of tax monies. Since its founding in 1903, the Association's mission has been to provide wholesome, educational athletics for the secondary schools of Indiana. Its 410 member high schools - public, institutional, parochial and private - pay no annual membership fee or incur entry fees to play in the Association's tournaments. A state tournament series is conducted annually in 22 sports, 10 for girls, 10 for boys and two co-ed (unified flag football and track and field). A 19-person board of directors, elected by member school principals, governs the organization.
