E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, gmail. com, etc.) will not be accepted.

NO CHILDREN, **PLEASE**: With the exception of high school students representing their school's newspaper, yearbook, radio or television station, and who have a team participating, no young people or children will be issued media credentials or be allowed in the working media area.

MEDIA WILL-CALL: Approved requests will be available for pickup at the northwest corner stadium entrance beginning at 5 pm on Friday and at 9:30 am ET on Saturday.

MEDIA PARKING: While no specific media parking is available, we recommend using the Barnhill Parking Garage which is just across New York Street to the north of the stadium. Each vehicle will be charged \$10 to park.

SEAT ASSIGNMENTS: Except where permanent lines have been installed for those that have ordered them, an open seating policy will be used in both press boxes.

WIRELESS INTERNET: Free wireless access will be available in the press box. Please see Communications Assistant Trey Brown who will be on site to assist you.



Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the state finals tournament.

The recipient of the 2018-19 IHSAA Outstanding Soccer Official in the state of Indiana is Ron Harnage of Indianapolis. Harnage was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials Associations in Indiana.

There are more than 7,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Prior to arriving in Indiana, Ron served as a state official in Virginia and Maryland. Since moving to Indiana, he has given of his time and talent in working eight (8) IHSAA sectional soccer tournaments. He has been a part of five (5) different regional crews, two (2) semi-state crews, and two (2) state finals crews.

Ron has been a licensed soccer official in Indiana for the past eight (8) years, but has called the game for over 21. He currently serves as the Chairperson for the Crossroads Officials' Association. In addition to his Association responsibilities, Ron has been instrumental in the recruitment, mentoring, and training of IHSAA soccer officials. His dedication and loyalty to his sport, student athletes, his fellow officials, and the IHSAA have been exceptional.

- Top-ranked Wheeler returns to state championship match for the second year in a row and faces a rematch of last year's final with Evansville Mater Dei.
