KATHY BROWN-SPARROW OF EVANSVILLE TO BE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.



Kathryn "Kathy" Brown-Sparrow is the recipient of the 2019-20 IHSAA Outstanding Volleyball Official Award in the state of Indiana.

A licensed volleyball official for 27 years, Kathy is and has been the Volleyball Chairperson for the Southern Indiana Officials Association.

She assists area schools with getting volleyball officials for their matches including all grades. Kathy also volunteers to officiate in church and youth leagues, team teaches an officiating class at the University of Southern Indiana, and is currently licensed as a swimming official as well.

She has worked 22 Sectionals, 13 Regionals, five (5) Semi-States and four (4) State Finals matches during her career. She also serves as a Local Association Clinician and her favorite part of being an official is watching the athletes mature and the officials she has met and become friends with over the years.

Kathy is a 1979 graduate of Evansville Mater Dei High School, and studied Education at St. Mary's of the Woods and Accounting at University of Southern Indiana.

Brown-Sparrow was selected for this honor by a committee representing the official's associations. In Indiana there are 24 associations made up of more than 6,000 men and women who give up much of their personal time to assist in providing wholesome, worthwhile, and healthy activities for the student-athletes in our state. Statewide, there are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 18 sports.

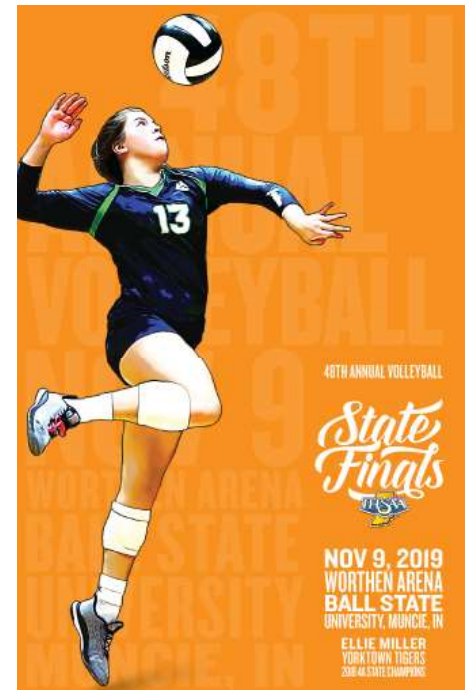

- Blackhawks aiming for school's second volleyball state title.
- One of two Delaware County teams competing on Saturday (Wapahani in 2A).
- Lost twice to 2A state finalist Wapahani this season - 3-1 in Oct. 3 road match and 3-2 at home on Oct. 9.
- Team has not given up a set in its six tournament matches and seven overall.
- Defeated two ranked opponents this tournament:
#8 Covington 3-0 in regional semifinals

- Martina Demarchi is ranked 5th in the state with 112 service aces while Emma Clark ranks 9th with 101.

- One of two Delaware County teams competing on Saturday (Cowan in Class A).
- Defeated Class A state finalist and conference rival Cowan twice this season: 3-1 on Oct. 3 and a 3-2 road win on Oct. 9.
- Mallory Summers is ranked among the top hitters with 452 kills.
- Alyvia Smith is ranked among the state leaders with 516 digs.
- Mid-Eastern Conference champions this season with a 9-0 record.
- Returned three starters from last year's 25-9 team.
- Defeated one ranked opponent during its tournament run in #9 Fairfield (3-0) for the semi-state title.
- Head coach Kati Weir is in her first season as a head coach. While a high school student at Yorktown, she played No. 1 singles for the school's tennis team which reached the 2010 state finals. She was also a member of the school's 2011 volleyball state championship team and 2009 state runner-up squad.

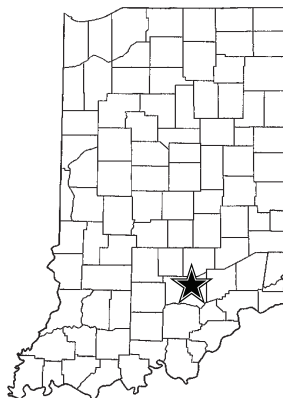

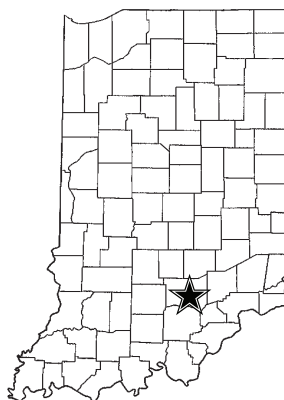

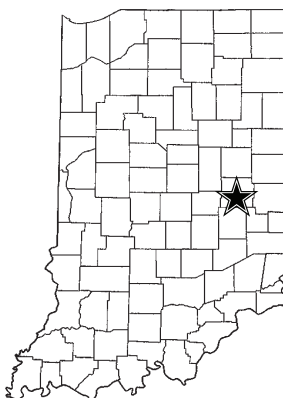
