MEDIA CREDENTIALS: The 2021-22 IHSAA State Finals Media Credential issued previously for the girls golf and boys tennis state finals is good for admission. For those outlets without credentials and planning to cover the event, please apply by e-mailing your request (with name of individual applying) to IHSAA Sports Information Director Jason Wille at jwille@ihsaa.org. E-mail requests MUST originate from a recognized business account; e-mails from personal accounts (ie: yahoo.com, gmail.com, etc.) will not be accepted.

NO CHILDREN, PLEASE: With the exception of high school students representing their school's newspaper, yearbook, radio or television station, and who have a team participating, no young people or children will be issued media credentials or be allowed in the working media area.

MEDIA WILL-CALL: Approved requests will be available for pickup at the will-call windows at the northwest corner stadium entrance.

MEDIA PARKING: While no specific media parking is available, we recommend using IUPUI's Barnhill Garage (fee required) just across New York Street to the north of the stadium.

OFFICIAL PROGRAMS/BOX SCORES: Official programs will be available along with box scores following each championship match. Interviews may be conducted with players and coaches on the sidelines following the award ceremonies.

POST-GAME GUIDELINES: IHSAA.tv.org personnel will have priority in conducting interviews with coaches and players on the field immediately following each match. If time permits before the awards ceremony, additional interviews may be conducted. Otherwise, all interviews will be conducted off the field following the awards ceremony and team photograph session. The post-game ceremonies order will be as follows:

JASPER'S LAWRENCE LONER TO BE HONORED WITH OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2021-22 IHSAA Outstanding Soccer Official in the state of Indiana is Lawrence Loner from Jasper, Indiana. Lawrence was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Lawrence has been licensed in the sport of soccer for 29 years and given his time and talent in working all 28 tournaments for our student athletes. He has been a crew member for 11 different regionals, nine (9) semi-state games, and has had seven (7) state finals appearances!

Lawrence is an educator by trade, majoring in English and minoring in both philosophy and theology at St. Meinrad.

Officiating soccer has taken Lawrence across the globe to Brazil, Germany, Jamaica, England, Ireland, Guatemala ... to name only a few. He now gives locally to the USSF and high school programs within Dubois county.

In his spare time, Lawrence has served as a school board member and president, parish council member, sings in his church choir, works with St. Vincent DePaul, is a religious education teacher through his church and works with Special Olympics soccer events. Loner currently serves in a leadership role as a state soccer clinician for the IHSAA. He continues to be instrumental in the recruitment, mentoring, and training of IHSAA soccer officials across southern Indiana. His dedication and loyalty to his sport, our student athletes, his fellow officials, and the IHSAA have been exceptional.
