## WAYNE PATTERSON TO BE HONORED POSTHUMOUSLY WITH OFFICIALS AWARD

The late Wayne Patterson of Washington, Indiana is the recipient of the 2023 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of baseball. Wayne will be honored posthumously in a special ceremony during this weekend's Baseball State Finals.



Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year. Wayne was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials associations in Indiana.

Wayne was a licensed baseball official for 27 years and officiated 23 sectionals, 19 regionals, five (5) semi-state contests, and four (4) State Finals. He was a member of the Southwestern Officials Association and previously served as an IHSAA baseball certification clinician from 2015-2018. Wayne was also a licensed football, basketball, and softball official.

Wayne also spent time umpiring for the Dubois County Bombers, numerous AAU baseball events in Jasper, and the 10U Baseball World Series in 2004 and 2007.

Wayne, a 1973 graduate of Barr-Reeve High School, used umpiring as a way to stay close to the sport of baseball throughout adulthood and to give back to the youth in his community. He enjoyed connecting with kids over their mutual love of the game.

Wayne Patterson passed away on February 3, 2022 and is survived by his significant other, Sandy Harbstreit, and daughters, Rachel Blythe and Sara Carley.

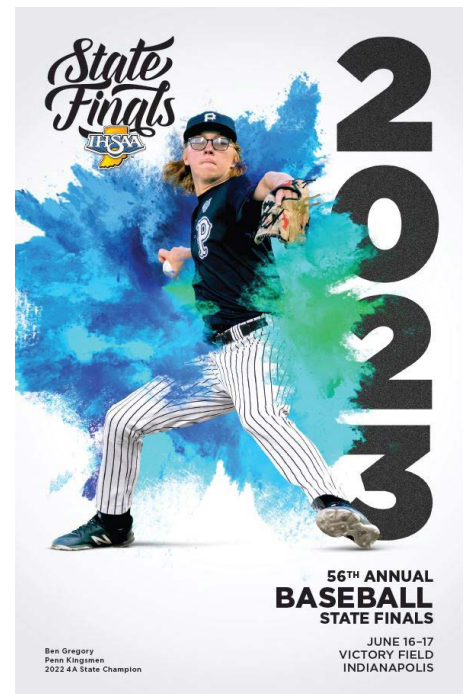

## LAFAYETTE CENTRAL CATHOLIC KNIGHTS (24-11)

### IHSBCA Coaches Poll: #3

- Defending 1A champion Lafayette Central Catholic chasing state record-extending ninth title (currently tied with Andean and LaPorte with eight).
- Knights playing in their record 11th state championship game (8-2 in previous final games including last year's 4-1 win over Tecumseh). This also the school's 13th trip to the state finals, second-most to Jasper's 17.
- With a victory, LCC coach Tim Bordenet would win his state record-extending ninth championship (currently tied with Andean's Dave Pishkur). Bordenet is a 1987 Central Catholic graduate.
- Finished second in the Hoosier Conference with an 8-1 record this season.
- Team returned eight starters from last season's 27-6 team and have won 13 consecutive state tournament games to this point.
- Knights are one of four defending state champions in this year's state finals, the first time that's happened since the multiple class era began in 1998.

IHSBCA Coaches Poll: #10

- Defending state champion Illiana Christian returns to the state championship game for the second year in a row after topping Centerville 10-1 in last year's final game.
- School has won 11 of its last 13 games entering the championship contest.
