**LAFAYETTE'S TOM MECKLEBURG TO
BE HONORED WITH OFFICIALS AWARD**

Tom Mecklenburg of Lafayette, Indiana is the recipient of the 2023 Interscholastic Athletic Official Association Award for excellence in the sport of Softball. Tom will be honored during an on-field ceremony at this weekend's IHSAA State Finals.

The Indiana High School Athletic Association, in cooperation with the National Federation of Interscholastic Officials Association, recognizes and honors an outstanding official in each of 11 sports during the school year.



Tom is a member of the Western Indiana Officials Association and has been a licensed softball official for 23 years, during which he has officiated 18 sectionals, 14 regionals, seven (7) semi-states, and four (4) state championship games in 2010, 2014, 2017, and 2022. He is also a licensed basketball and volleyball official and has officiated two Volleyball State Finals.

Tom has always been an active member of his community. He served on the Board of Directors for Food Finders Food Bank for 8 years, two of which he served as President of the Board. He also ushered at St. Lawrence Church for nearly 35 years, 20 of which he was the church's Head Usher. Tom also spent many years umpiring for the youth softball leagues in the Lafayette area, as well as overseeing various charity softball and basketball games.

Tom recognizes the importance and impact sports can have in one's life and takes pride in providing positive experiences to the youth in his community.

Tom is a longtime employee of Evonik Corp and currently works as Senior Production Coordinator. A 1975 graduate of Lafayette Central Catholic High School, Tom is also a former member of the United States Navy. He currently resides in Lafayette with his wife Debbie. Together, they have six children and nine grandchildren.

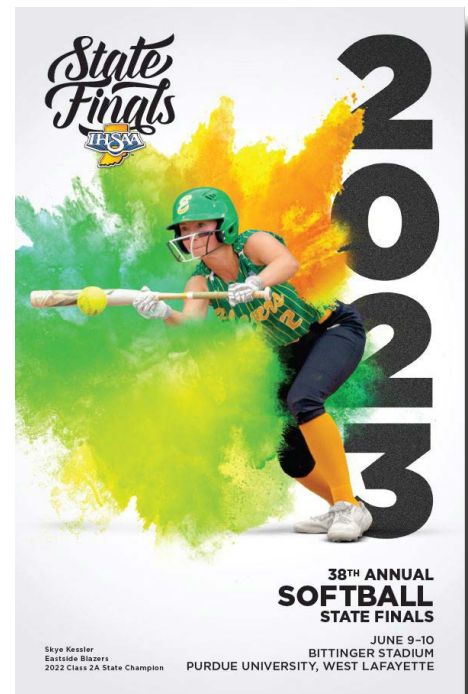

SCAI Coaches Poll: #7

- Caston playing for school's first softball state championship. In fact, this is the first Caston team to ever appear in a state championship game in any sport.
- The lone team in this year's field making its first softball state finals appearance.
- Would become first Fulton County team to win a state title since 2004 when Rochester won the 2A girls basketball crown.
- Comets won school's very first softball sectional crown this year and have advanced all the way to the final game of the season.
- Defeated two ranked teams this tournament: def. #10 West Central 10-4 in sectional opener def. #4 Cowan 5-3 for the semi-state championship.
- Hoosier North Conference champions with a 7-0 record.
- Returned eight starters from last year's 19-win Comets team.

TECUMSEH BRAVES (24-9)

SCAI Coaches Poll: #1

- Top-ranked Tecumseh looking to repeat as Class 1A state champions and win their third crown in seven seasons. Eight starters return from last year's title team.
- Braves making school's 11th state finals appearance (third-most in state history) and 10th to the championship game (second-most).
- Braves chasing fifth state title. With a victory, would become one of four schools with as many (Center Grove 7, New Palestine 6, Roncalli 5).
- For the second straight year, finished tied for third in the Pocket Athletic Conference, finishing with a 9-3 record this season. One of two Pocket Athletic Conference teams playing this weekend (North Posey).
- Fell to 2A state finalist North Posey 9-2 on April 12 and 4A state finalist Roncalli 10-0 on April 22.
- Defeated two ranked teams this tournament: def. #2 Barr-Reeve 3-2 (8 inn.) in regional title game def. #7 Indianapolis Lutheran 20-0 in semi-state championship game.
- Gordon Wood has coached the Braves to all four of its previous state titles during his 17 years leading the team. With a victory, Wood would become just the third coach with five state titles (Ed Marcum, New Palestine with 6; Russ Milligan, Center Grove with 5).
- School's volleyball team finished as 1A volleyball state runner-up falling in five sets to Fort Wayne Blackhawk Christian last Nov. 5 at Ball State's Worthen Arena.
