OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

TERRE HAUTE'S RHONDA COOMBS TO BE HONORED

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2023-24 IHSAA Outstanding Volleyball Official in the state of Indiana is Rhonda Coombs from Terre Haute, Indiana. Rhonda was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials'

associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe,



competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.

Rhonda has been a licensed volleyball official for 23 years and has officiated 13 sectionals, four (4) regionals, three (3) semi-states, and two (2) state finals appearances. She is a member of the Wabash Valley Officials Association and has served the association in various roles including Volleyball Chair, Board Member, and Secretary. Additionally, Rhonda also volunteers as an IHSAA rules interpreter, helping her fellow officials and volleyball coaches understand the various rules of the game, and as an IHSAA clinician, providing training and lessons to officials in her community.

Coombs also takes time to officiate boys volleyball matches in Indiana, Special Olympics volleyball, and basketball contests, as well as some USA Volleyball and NAIA collegiate matches. She has also been known to donate her game checks to school fundraisers such as Breast Cancer Awareness Pink Nights and school scholarship funds.

Rhonda's favorite thing about officiating is being able to stay in the game and enjoying the action from a different perspective. She's also grateful for the relationships that she has with the coaches, officials, and athletic directors around the state.

Rhonda resides in Terre Haute with her husband and together, they have three children and six grandchildren.






