OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

FOUNTAIN TOWN'S CARMEN HAWK TO BE HONORED AT STATE FINALS

Carmen Hawk of Fountaintown, Indiana is the recipient of the 2025-26 IHSAA Outstanding Official Award for the sport of Girls Basketball.

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors one outstanding official in each sport who has demonstrated exceptional leadership, dedication, and service to their sport, the IHSAA, their fellow officials, and Indiana's student-athletes.

Carmen was selected for this

honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in 11 sports.



These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes in Indiana.

Hawk has been a licensed IHSAA official for 25 years and is currently a member of the Fall Creek Officials Association and the Indiana Officials Association.

Throughout her IHSAA basketball officiating career, Carmen has worked extensively across all tournament levels, including 16 sectionals, eight (8) regionals, three (3) semi-states, and two IHSAA Girls Basketball State Finals in 2022 (4A) and 2025 (4A). She is also licensed in volleyball and softball and has officiated in four (4) IHSAA Volleyball State Finals and two (2) IHSAA Softball State Finals.

A respected leader within the officiating community, Hawk has held numerous leadership roles, including IHSOLA Advisory Representative, Fall Creek Officials Association Board Member, and Technology Director for Lime City Officials Association. She has also been a featured speaker at the IHSAA Student Leadership Conference on numerous occasions, where she shared her experience as an official to Indiana's brightest student athletes. In addition, Carmen has served as an IHSAA Rules Clinician, contributing to the education and development of officials statewide since 2018.

Carmen's service extends beyond the court through her long-standing involvement with Special Olympics Indiana in Shelby and Huntington Counties.

Hawk began officiating right out of high school. It was her way to give back to her community and stay involved in the sports she loved growing up. She finds great fulfillment in mentoring new officials and working with Indiana's student-athletes!

Outside of officiating, Hawk is a sixth-generation family farm owner/operator at Nigh Heritage Farms in Shelbyville. She and her husband Andrew have been married for 21 years and have three children: Jacob (19), Abby (17), and Graham (10).


As an organization that emphasizes keeping education at the forefront of high school athletics, the Indiana High School Athletic Association is proud to shine a light on student-centered educators.
