OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

WESTFIELD'S MATT KNEZEVICH TO BE HONORED

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2025-26 IHSAA Outstanding Official Award for Girls Volleyball is Matt Knezevich of Westfield, Indiana. Matt was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Knezevich has been a licensed volleyball official in Indiana for 31 years. During that time, he has been assigned to 25 girls volleyball sectionals, 18 regionals, and 11 semi-states. Matt was assigned to officiate Saturday's Class 4A Final, his seventh Girls Volleyball State Championship Match! In addition, Matt officiated during the Inaugural Boys Volleyball State Finals in May 2025. He is also a licensed basketball official.

Knezevich is a member of the Fall Creek Officials Association and has served in various leadership roles within the organization, including Volleyball Chair, FCOA Vice-President, and FCOA Board Member. He has worked as an IHSAA clinician, assisting with clinics and trainings in service to other officials in his community, and also as a Rules Interpreter, helping coaches and officials understand NFHS rule changes and rule clarifications. Matt has been vital to the recruitment of officials in Central Indiana.

Outside of his work with the IHSAA, Matt is licensed with the NCAA and has worked numerous collegiate matches as a referee and line judge. He has volunteered with Special Olympics Indiana for over 30 years. He also works as a Volleyball Liaison for ReReps, an officiating education system that provides training and curriculum for sports officials.

Officiating has given Matt the opportunity to connect and build relationships with so many student-athletes, administrators, and officials in Indiana. He is grateful to see the growth of the younger officials he's worked with and mentored over the years!

Matt resides in Westfield with his wife and, together, they have two children.

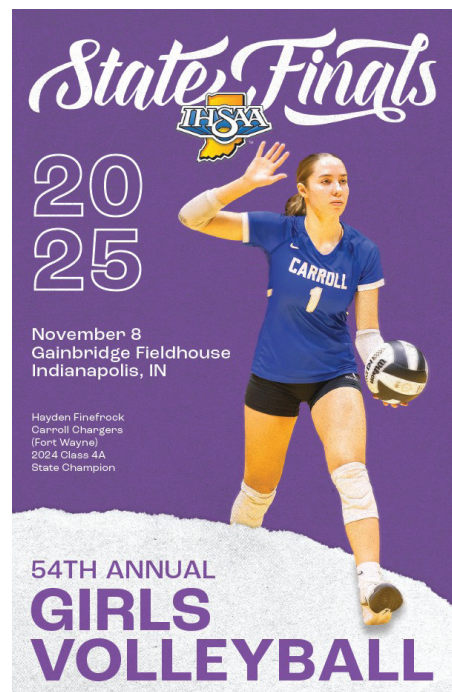

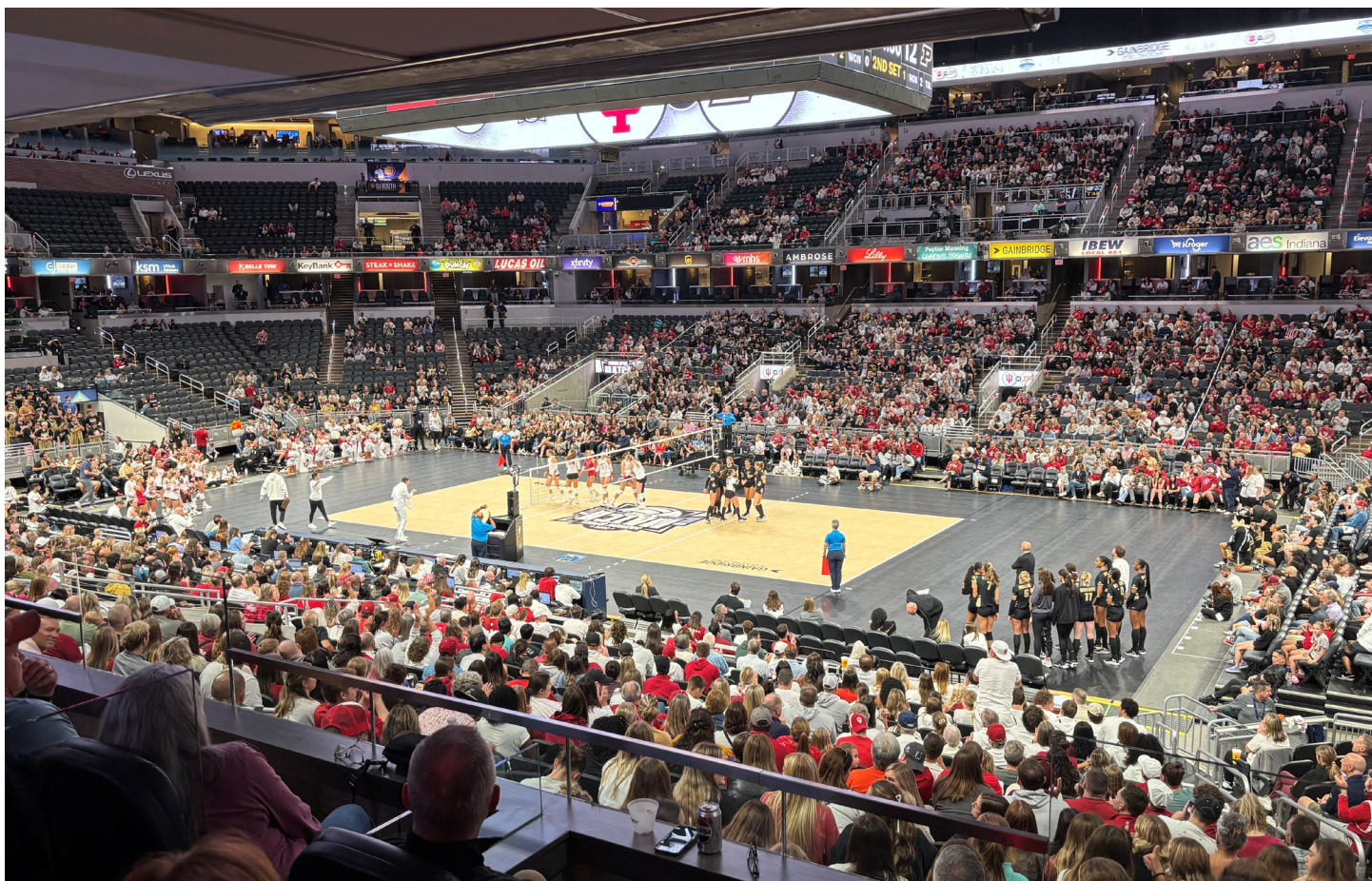
As an organization that emphasizes keeping education at the forefront of high school athletics, the Indiana High School Athletic Association is proud to shine a light on student-centered educators.

- Second-ranked Faith Christian making its second consecutive state championship match appearance.
- School will face top-ranked Trinity Lutheran in a rematch of last year's championship contest. It's the first rematch of a 1A final since 2007 when Loogootee and Marquette Catholic squared off for the third straight year.
- Five starters returned from last year's 28-5 state runner-up team.
- Eagles defeated last year's 2A state champion Western Boone 2-0 on Sept. 20. They lost a 3-1 decision to 2A state finalist Benton Central in their last regular season match on Oct. 9
- Eagles will meet their fourth top 10-ranked team in six matches this tournament when they face No. 1 Trinity. Defeated #8 South Newton and #4 Rossville, both by 3-1 counts, in last Saturday's semi-state. Also knocked out #10 town rival Lafayette Central Catholic 3-0 in the sectional semifinals on Oct. 18.
- The 3-1 semi-state championship victory over #4 Rossville avenged two regular season losses to the Hornets.
- Midwest Conference champions with a 7-0 record.
- Fifth year coach Josh Hill is also the school's athletic director and track coach.

- Top-ranked and defending state champion Trinity Lutheran returns to the state title match for a second consecutive year and fifth time overall.
- The Cougars will face second-ranked Faith Christian, the team they defeated in three sets in last year's final. It's the first rematch of a 1A final since 2007 when Loogootee and Marquette Catholic squared off for the third straight year.
- Team defeated #5 Oldenburg, #9 Greenwood Christian, and #3 Springs Valley on this tournament trail.
- Trinity Lutheran had won 36 consecutive sets in state tournament action before dropping Set 1 to Springs Valley in last Saturday night's semi-state championship. The streak dated back to last year and is the 6th longest in tournament history.
- Cougars returned only one starter from last year's 30-8 state championship team.
- Defeated Rising Sun 3-0 on Oct. 18 to claim its 12th consecutive sectional crown.
- The last state champion with double digit losses was 2A Wapahani which finished 27-11 in 2015. The last 1A state champion with double digit losses was Cowan which finished 27-10 in 2012.

- Second-ranked and defending state champion Roncalli making its fifth state championship match appearance. The school is looking to repeat as 3A winners and is 4-0 in state title match opportunities.
- Roncalli had won 28 consecutive sets in state tournament action before #7 New Palestine took Set 2 in their 3-1 victory in the sectional championship match. The streak dated back to last year and is the ninth longest in state tournament history.
- Team returned five starters from last year's 35-0 state championship team.
- Royals have knocked out four straight ranked opponents including #7 New Palestine, #2 Indianapolis Cathedral, #4 Brownstown Central, and #8 Tri-West Hendricks. The win over Cathedral avenged a pair of regular season losses to the Irish.
- The team's regular season included a victory over last year's 4A state runner-up Yorktown (2-1) on Aug. 30 and a 3-1 road loss to defending state champion and 4A state finalist Carroll in the regular season finale on Oct. 11. It was the only set that Carroll lost during its regular season.

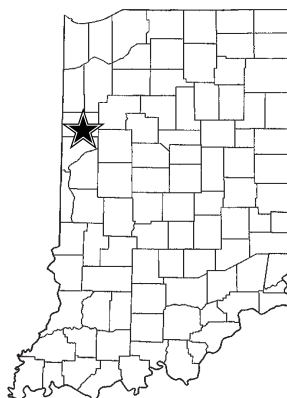
