OUTSTANDING OFFICIALS AWARD

TERRY GIBSON TO BE HONORED WITH GIRLS OFFICIALS AWARD

Each year, the Indiana High School Athletic Association honors an outstanding official in each sport during the State Finals Tournament.

The recipient of the 2025-26 IHSAA Outstanding Official Award for Girls Soccer is Terry Gibson from Portage, Indiana. Terry was selected for this honor by a committee representing the 24 officials' associations in Indiana. There are more than 6,000 officials licensed by the IHSAA in all sports. These officials work tirelessly to provide safe, competitive environments for over 160,000 student athletes.



Terry has been licensed in the sport of Soccer for 15 years and has overseen 17 boys' and girls' soccer sectionals, 15 regionals, and 6 semi-state contests. Additionally, he has officiated two Girls State Championship Matches (2018, 2022). Terry is also licensed in Basketball and Volleyball.

Gibson is a member of the Lake County Officials Association and currently serves as Meeting Coordinator for the association. He also volunteers his time as an IHSAA Clinician, assisting with clinics and trainings each year in service to other officials in his community. Lastly, Terry works as a mentor to several younger officials, using his experience to help guide them through their first few years of licensure.

Outside of his work with the IHSAA, Terry has been licensed US Soccer Official for 13 years and coached high school soccer in New York for 15 years.

Officiating gives Terry the chance to give back to the game he's loved since childhood. Having played and coached previously, officiating soccer provides him with a new perspective and he truly enjoys the excitement and enthusiasm of student-athletes today.

Terry resides in Portage with his wife and, together, they have three daughters and eight grandchildren! He works as a Pastor for First Baptist Church in Portage and has been a pastor for 36 years.

- Second-ranked Blackhawk Christian chasing school's first boys soccer state championship.
- Braves earned their way to Indianapolis by beating three ranked teams during tournament action. Defeated #6 Westview in the sectional semis, #12 Argos 5-0 in the regional semis, and knocked out top-ranked and defending state champion Covenant Christian in penalty kicks for the semi-state crown.
- With a win, Blackhawk would become just the second Fort Wayne school to win a boys soccer state title. Fort Wayne Canterbury has won a state record seven crowns.
- Blackhawk defeated Canterbury 4-1 to win its first sectional championship in nine years.
- Eight starters returned from last year's 13-5-1 team.
- Head coach Sam Meyer was a member of Belmont High School's football state championship team in 2008 and its state runner-up wrestling team in 2006.

- Indianapolis Scecina, winners of seven straight, are on the cusp of winning school's first boys soccer title and the first in a boys sport since 1991 when the football team carted off the 2A trophy.
- Crusaders are making their first appearance in the boys soccer state finals and beat a pair of ranked teams in their last two matches to reach this point. Defeated #17 Southwestern (Hanover) 3-0 to win first regional crown in nine years and followed up with a 5-0 drubbing of #15 Providence, last year's state runner-up.
- Crusaders met 2A state finalist Bishop Chatard twice last month playing to a 2-2 draw in the first meeting and losing in penalty kicks in the follow up contest.
- Scecina returned five starters from last year's squad that finished just 8-11.
- Ended in fourth place in this season's Indiana Crossroads Conference race with a 2-3 mark.
- With win, third-year head coach Quinn Cloghessy would become the first person to lead to different schools to a boys soccer state championship. He coached his alma mater Hammond Bishop Noll to the 2018 2A boys crown.

- After settling for a runner-up finish a year ago, top-ranked Marian is the lone returnee from last year's girls state finals participants.
- Knights are playing in third state championship match in five seasons and chasing second crown and first in Class 2A (2012 1A).
